Efficient Delivery & Scoring

The E-Proficiency Profile is a two-hour exam with 2 sections (54 questions in each section, 108 questions total). The exam may be administered either in a single 2-hour testing session or in two separate 1-hour testing sessions. A score and proficiency profile rating may be provided immediately upon completion.

A one-hour abbreviated version is also available for institutions maximizing student availability within limited institution assessment delivery window
